

PROPERTY IN TRANSIT COVERAGES F AND G

1. "We" pay for loss to property covered under Coverages F or G while it is in transit, but not while being transported by or in the custody of a common or contract carrier.
 - 1) leakage, evaporation, shrinkage, breakage, heat, or cold;
 - 2) being scented, moulded, rusted, rotted, soured, or changed in flavor; or
 - 3) bending, denting, chipping, marring, or scratching;
 2. "We" do not pay for:
 - a. loss of or injury to "livestock" or poultry, except against accident causing death or making death necessary; unless caused by fire, lightning, windstorm, flood, explosion, collision, or overturn; or
 - b. loss of profit, loss of use, or loss of market; g. loss of or damage to tarpaulins, tools, repair equipment, wrapping materials, and equipment for loading and unloading which are carried on the vehicle.
 - c. loss or damage caused by shifting of load, poor packing or rough handling, or unexplained shortage, including inventory shortage;
 - d. breakage of eggs;
 - e. loss caused by insects, vermin, or inherent vice;
 - f. loss caused by:
 3. The most "we" pay is \$5,000 per occurrence or the "limit" that applies to the covered property, whichever is less.
- All other "terms" of the policy apply.
